**"AN ACT CONCERNING A PREFERENCE FOR CONNECTICUT  
GROWN PROTEIN IN CERTAIN STATE CONTRACTS."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. Section 26-28 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4      following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2013*):

5      (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this section, the  
6      fees for firearms hunting, archery hunting, trapping and sport fishing  
7      licenses or for the combination thereof shall be as follows: (1) Resident  
8      firearms hunting license, nineteen dollars; (2) resident fishing license,  
9      twenty-eight dollars; (3) [resident marine waters fishing license, ten  
10     dollars; (4) one-day resident marine waters fishing license, five dollars;  
11     (5)] resident all-waters fishing license, thirty-two dollars; [(6)] (4)  
12     resident combination license to fish in inland waters and firearms  
13     hunt, thirty-eight dollars; [(7)] (5) resident combination license to fish

14 in marine waters and firearms hunt, twenty-five dollars; [(8)] (6)  
15 resident combination license to fish in all waters and firearms hunt,  
16 thirty-eight dollars; [(9)] (7) resident combination license to fish in all  
17 waters and bow and arrow permit to hunt deer and small game issued  
18 pursuant to section 26-86c, sixty-five dollars; [(10)] (8) resident firearms  
19 super sport license to fish in all waters and firearms hunt, firearms  
20 private land shotgun or rifle deer permit issued pursuant to section 26-  
21 86a, and permit to hunt wild turkey during the spring season on  
22 private land issued pursuant to section 26-48a, eighty dollars; [(11)] (9)  
23 resident archery super sport license to fish in all waters, bow and  
24 arrow permit to hunt deer and small game issued pursuant to section  
25 26-86c and permit to hunt wild turkey during the spring season on  
26 private land issued pursuant to section 26-48a, eighty-two dollars;  
27 [(12)] (10) resident firearms super sport license to fish in all waters and  
28 firearms hunt, firearms private land shotgun or rifle deer permit,  
29 muzzleloader private land deer permit, pursuant to section 26-86 and  
30 private land permit to hunt wild turkey during spring season pursuant  
31 to section 26-48a, eighty-four dollars; [(13)] (11) resident firearms super  
32 sport license to fish in all waters and firearms hunt, migratory bird  
33 conservation stamp, and migratory bird harvest permit (HIP), sixty  
34 dollars; [(14)] (12) resident trapping license, thirty-four dollars; [(15)]  
35 (13) resident junior trapping license for persons under sixteen years of  
36 age, eleven dollars; [(16)] (14) junior firearms hunting license, eleven  
37 dollars; [(17)] (15) nonresident firearms hunting license, ninety-one  
38 dollars; [(18)] (16) nonresident inland waters fishing license, fifty-five  
39 dollars; [(19)] (17) nonresident inland waters fishing license for a  
40 period of three consecutive days, twenty-two dollars; [(20)] nonresident  
41 marine waters fishing license, fifteen dollars; (21) nonresident marine  
42 waters fishing license for a period of three consecutive days, eight  
43 dollars; (22) (18) nonresident all-waters fishing license, sixty-three  
44 dollars; [(23)] (19) nonresident combination license to firearms hunt  
45 and inland waters fish, one hundred ten dollars; [(24)] (20) nonresident  
46 combination license to fish in all waters and firearms hunt, one  
47 hundred twenty dollars; [(25)] (21) nonresident combination license to  
48 fish in marine waters and firearms hunt, ninety-four dollars; and [(26)]

49 (22) nonresident trapping license, two hundred fifty dollars. Persons  
50 sixty-five years of age and over who have been residents of this state  
51 for not less than one year and who meet the requirements of  
52 subsection (b) of section 26-31 may be issued an annual license to  
53 firearms hunt or to fish or combination license to fish and firearms  
54 hunt or a license to trap without fee. The issuing agency shall indicate  
55 on a combination license the specific purpose for which such license is  
56 issued. The town clerk shall retain a recording fee of one dollar for  
57 each license issued by him.

58 (b) Any nonresident residing in one of the New England states or  
59 the state of New York may procure a license to hunt or to fish or to  
60 hunt and fish for the same fee or fees as a resident of this state if he is a  
61 resident of a state the laws of which allow the same privilege to  
62 residents of this state.

63 (c) The fee for a group fishing license, as described in subsection (h)  
64 of section 26-30, shall be two hundred fifty dollars.

65 (d) There shall be no fee for any: (1) Resident marine waters fishing  
66 license, (2) one-day resident marine waters fishing license, (3)  
67 nonresident marine waters fishing license, or (4) nonresident marine  
68 waters fishing license for a period of three consecutive days.

69 Sec. 502. Subsection (a) of section 26-28b of the general statutes is  
70 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*  
71 *1, 2013*):

72 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), (d), (e) or (f) of this section  
73 and other provisions of this chapter providing specific license  
74 exemption, no person more than sixteen years of age shall take,  
75 attempt to take or assist in taking any fish or bait species in the marine  
76 district by any method or land marine fish and bait species in the state  
77 regardless of where such marine fish or bait species are taken, without  
78 first having obtained a marine waters fishing license. [as provided in  
79 section 26-28c.]

80       Sec. 503. Section 26-28c of the general statutes is repealed. (*Effective*  
81       *July 1, 2013*)"
