"AN ACT ELIMINATING CERTAIN MUNICIPAL MANDATES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 22-331a of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2013*):

5 Any two or more contiguous towns [each of which has a population
6 of less than twenty-five thousand, and which] that have or will
7 provide a dog pound facility within their region, by action of their
8 legislative bodies, may agree to be served by a regional animal control
9 officer. Upon certification of such agreement to the commissioner with
10 assurances from the towns so certifying that they will provide and
11 continue to provide adequate facilities and compensation for such
12 officer, the commissioner may, after giving due regard to the regional
13 aspects of the proposed facilities and whether the proposed region
14 would be in the best interests of the towns so certifying, establish such
15 region. Each person so appointed shall have the same powers and

16 duties within the region to which he is assigned as a municipal animal
17 control officer in each town therein. All costs of maintaining and
18 operating such pounds and administering and enforcing the laws
19 relating to dogs within such regions shall be paid in accordance with
20 the provisions of the agreement certified to the commissioner under
21 this section."
