**"AN ACT CONCERNING AN AGREEMENT AMONG THE STATES
TO ELECT THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES BY
NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 3-69a of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
5 *passage*):

6 [(a) (1) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, the funds received
7 under this part, excluding the proceeds from the sale of property
8 deposited in the Special Abandoned Property Fund in accordance with
9 section 3-62h, shall be deposited in the General Fund.]

10 [(2)] (a) For the fiscal year ending June 30, [2006] 2014, and each
11 fiscal year thereafter, [a portion of the funds received under this part
12 shall, upon deposit in the General Fund, be credited to the Citizens'
13 Election Fund established in section 9-701 as follows: (A) For the fiscal

14 year ending June 30, 2006, seventeen million dollars, (B) for the fiscal
 15 year ending June 30, 2007, sixteen million dollars, (C) for the fiscal year
 16 ending June 30, 2008, seventeen million three hundred thousand
 17 dollars, and (D) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, and each fiscal
 18 year thereafter, the amount deposited for the preceding fiscal year,
 19 adjusted in accordance with any change in the consumer price index
 20 for all urban consumers for such preceding fiscal year, as published by
 21 the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. The
 22 State Treasurer shall determine such adjusted amount not later than
 23 thirty days after the end of such preceding fiscal year] the cash portion
 24 of all funds received under this part, including the proceeds from the
 25 sale of property, shall be deposited in the General Fund except as
 26 provided in section 3-62h.

27 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Wherever a reference to
 28 chapter 157 of the general statutes or to any section contained in said
 29 chapter 157 is used, such reference shall be deleted.

30 (b) The Legislative Commissioners' Office shall, in codifying the
 31 provisions of this section, make such technical, grammatical and
 32 punctuation changes as are necessary to carry out the purposes of this
 33 section.

34 Sec. 503. Sections 9-700 to 9-718, inclusive, 9-750 and 9-751 of the
 35 general statutes are repealed. (*Effective from passage*)"
