"AN ACT PROHIBITING HUNTING IN PROXIMITY TO WILDLIFE PRESERVES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 10-303 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
5 *passage*):

6 (a) The authority in charge of any building or property owned,
7 operated or leased by the state or any municipality therein shall grant
8 to the Department of Rehabilitation Services a permit to operate in
9 such building or on such property a food service facility, a vending
10 machine or a stand for the vending of newspapers, periodicals,
11 confections, tobacco products, food and such other articles as such
12 authority approves when, in the opinion of such authority, such
13 facility, machine or stand is desirable in such location. Any person
14 operating such a stand in any such location on October 1, 1945, shall be
15 permitted to continue such operation, but upon such person's ceasing

16 such operation such authority shall grant a permit for continued
 17 operation to the Department of Rehabilitation Services. The
 18 department may establish a training facility at any such location. The
 19 requirements of this subsection shall not apply to any state park or
 20 forest under the custody and control of the Commissioner of Energy
 21 and Environmental Protection.

22 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Energy
 23 and Environmental Protection shall issue a request for proposals for
 24 the operation of the food service facilities located in the state parks and
 25 forests under the custody and control of the commissioner. In
 26 awarding any contract for the operation of such food service facilities,
 27 the commissioner shall award such contract to the highest responsible
 28 bidder. Nothing in this section or section 10-303 of the general statutes,
 29 as amended by this act, shall be construed to prohibit the Board of
 30 Education and Services for the Blind from bidding on any contract
 31 authorized pursuant to this section."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
