**"AN ACT PROHIBITING HUNTING IN PROXIMITY TO WILDLIFE PRESERVES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) The Department of Energy and  
4 Environmental Protection shall provide for the purchase of a lottery  
5 permit, at a fee of ten dollars, that allows the permittee to participate in  
6 a lottery for the opportunity to receive a license, at a fee of two  
7 hundred dollars, to hunt bear in a location and by a method of take  
8 designated by the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental  
9 Protection. Such designated location shall coincide with the  
10 department's deer management zones.

11 Sec. 502. Subsection (a) of section 10-303 of the general statutes is  
12 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*  
13 *passage*):

14 (a) The authority in charge of any building or property owned,

15 operated or leased by the state or any municipality therein shall grant  
 16 to the Department of Rehabilitation Services a permit to operate in  
 17 such building or on such property a food service facility, a vending  
 18 machine or a stand for the vending of newspapers, periodicals,  
 19 confections, tobacco products, food and such other articles as such  
 20 authority approves when, in the opinion of such authority, such  
 21 facility, machine or stand is desirable in such location. Any person  
 22 operating such a stand in any such location on October 1, 1945, shall be  
 23 permitted to continue such operation, but upon such person's ceasing  
 24 such operation such authority shall grant a permit for continued  
 25 operation to the Department of Rehabilitation Services. The  
 26 department may establish a training facility at any such location. The  
 27 requirements of this subsection shall not apply to any state park or  
 28 forest under the custody and control of the Commissioner of Energy  
 29 and Environmental Protection.

30 Sec. 503. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Energy  
 31 and Environmental Protection shall issue a request for proposals for  
 32 the operation of the food service facilities located in the state parks and  
 33 forests under the custody and control of the commissioner. In  
 34 awarding any contract for the operation of such food service facilities,  
 35 the commissioner shall award such contract to the highest responsible  
 36 bidder. Nothing in this section or section 10-303 of the general statutes,  
 37 as amended by this act, shall be construed to prohibit the Board of  
 38 Education and Services for the Blind from bidding on any contract  
 39 authorized pursuant to this section."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
