**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE COMMISSION FOR TECHNOLOGY
ADVANCEMENT."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (d) of section 16-247v of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2013*):

6 (d) Each telephone company and certified telecommunications
7 provider and the Commission for Technology Advancement or the
8 Department of Administrative Services, for services provided pursuant
9 to section 4d-80, as amended by this act, shall, to the extent permitted
10 under federal law, provide a bill credit to any subscriber of such
11 company or provider for any service outage of intrastate
12 telecommunications service, in an emergency, provided (1) such
13 service outage lasts for more than twenty-four consecutive hours, (2)
14 the subscriber notifies such company or provider of such service
15 outage not later than thirty days after the end of any such emergency,

16 (3) such service outage was not caused by the equipment, negligence
17 or wilful act of the subscriber or any other third party, (4) such service
18 outage affects more than ten per cent of any such company's or
19 provider's access lines, and (5) such service outage was not caused by
20 the failure of commercial power used to provide such intrastate
21 telecommunications service. The amount of any such credit shall equal
22 the proportionate share of such service not received during the billing
23 period during which such outage occurred. The provisions of this
24 subsection shall not apply to any certified competitive video service
25 provider, community antenna television company, holder of a
26 certificate of cable franchise authority or holder of a certificate of video
27 franchise authority that already provides credits pursuant to section
28 16-331l or 16-331w."
