"AN ACT CONCERNING WATER INFRASTRUCTURE AND CONSERVATION, MUNICIPAL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS AND UNPAID UTILITY ACCOUNTS AT MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS."

1 Strike section 1 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Public Utilities
4 Regulatory Authority shall authorize rates for each water company, as
5 defined in section 16-1 of the general statutes, that promote
6 comprehensive supply-side and demand-side water conservation. In
7 establishing such rates, the authority shall take into consideration
8 customers who are low water consumers, including those who have
9 already implemented conservation measures, state energy policies, the
10 capital intensive nature of sustaining water systems that minimize
11 water losses and the competition for capital for continued investments
12 in such systems. Such rates shall (1) prioritize demand projections that
13 recognize the effects of conservation and account for declining rates of

14 water consumption in order to minimize the use of a revenue
15 adjustment mechanism, as defined in section 3 of this act, following
16 general rate cases, and (2) consider (A) implementation of metering
17 and measures to provide timely price signals to consumers, (B)
18 multiyear rate plans, (C) measures to reduce system water losses, and
19 (D) alternative rate designs that promote conservation."
