**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE  
DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force  
4      to study the feasibility of establishing goals for mixed population  
5      public housing that would require approximately eighty-six per cent of  
6      such units to be reserved for persons over age sixty and approximately  
7      fourteen per cent of such units to be reserved for persons with  
8      disabilities. Such task force shall consider recommending legislation  
9      modeled after Massachusetts General Laws chapter 121B, section 39.

10      (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:

11      (1) Two appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;

12      (2) Two appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;

13      (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of  
14      Representatives;

- 15 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;
- 16 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of
- 17 Representatives; and
- 18 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate.
- 19 (c) Any member of the task force appointed under subdivision (1),
- 20 (2), (3), (4), (5) or (6) of subsection (b) of this section may be a member
- 21 of the General Assembly.
- 22 (d) All appointments to the task force shall be made not later than
- 23 thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy shall be
- 24 filled by the appointing authority.
- 25 (e) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president
- 26 pro tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the task
- 27 force, from among the members of the task force. Such chairpersons
- 28 shall schedule the first meeting of the task force, which shall be held
- 29 not later than sixty days after the effective date of this section.
- 30 (f) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the
- 31 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to housing
- 32 shall serve as administrative staff of the task force.
- 33 (g) Not later than January 1, 2014, the task force shall submit a
- 34 report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing
- 35 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 36 relating to housing, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a
- 37 of the general statutes. The task force shall terminate on the date that it
- 38 submits such report or January 1, 2014, whichever is later."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
