"AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE STATUTES."

1 Strike subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of section 1 and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(b) (1) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes or any
4 regulation, the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall not decline to
5 issue a motor vehicle operator's license to any applicant who meets the
6 licensure requirements provided in section 14-36 of the general statutes
7 but who cannot establish that he or she is legally present in the United
8 States or does not have a Social Security number if such applicant (A)
9 submits proof of residency in the state, (B) submits either two forms of
10 primary proof of identity or one form of primary proof of identity and
11 one form of secondary proof of identity, (C) files an affidavit with the
12 commissioner attesting that such applicant has filed an application to
13 legalize his or her immigration status or will file such an application as
14 soon as he or she is eligible to do so, and (D) if such person is eighteen

15 years of age or younger, provides proof that such applicant's parent or
16 legal guardian is a Connecticut taxpayer. Any form of primary proof of
17 identity, secondary proof of identity or proof of residency submitted to
18 the commissioner that is in a language other than English shall be
19 accompanied by a certified English translation of such document
20 prepared by a translator approved by the commissioner."
