"AN ACT CONCERNING ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR PERMITS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 30-16 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective June*
5 *1, 2014*):

6 (a) A manufacturer permit shall allow the manufacture of alcoholic
7 liquor and the storage, bottling and wholesale distribution and sale of
8 alcoholic liquor manufactured or bottled to permittees in this state and
9 without the state as may be permitted by law; but no such permit shall
10 be granted unless the place or the plan of the place of manufacture has
11 received the approval of the Department of Consumer Protection. Such
12 permit shall authorize the selling at retail from the premises of sealed
13 bottles and sealed jars of spirits distilled on the premises for

14 consumption off the premises, provided the holder of the
15 manufacturing permit produces not more than fifty thousand gallons
16 of spirits on the premises annually. Selling at retail from the premises
17 of sealed bottles and sealed jars of spirits distilled on the premises for
18 consumption off the premises shall be at a price at or above the posted
19 bottle price established pursuant to subsections (a) and (b) of section
20 30-68m, shall comply with the provisions of subsection (d) of section
21 30-91, as amended by this act, and shall permit not more than two and
22 one-quarter liters of spirits distilled on the premises to be sold to any
23 person on any day on which such sale is authorized under the
24 provisions of said subsection. A holder of a manufacturer permit may
25 apply for and shall receive an out-of-state shipper's permit for
26 manufacturing plants and warehouse locations outside the state
27 owned by such manufacturer or a subsidiary corporation thereof, at
28 least eighty-five per cent of the voting stock of which is owned by such
29 manufacturer, to bring into any of its plants or warehouses in the state
30 alcoholic liquors for reprocessing, repackaging, reshipment or sale
31 either (1) within the state to wholesaler permittees not owned or
32 controlled by such manufacturer, or (2) outside the state. A holder of a
33 manufacturer permit, except a manufacturer permit for cider, may
34 apply for and shall receive a wholesaler permit. The annual fee for a
35 manufacturer permit shall be one thousand eight hundred fifty dollars.

36 Sec. 2. Subsection (d) of section 30-91 of the general statutes is
37 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
38 *passage*):

39 (d) The sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor in places operating
40 under package store permits, drug store permits, manufacturer
41 permits, manufacturer permits for beer, manufacturer permits for beer
42 and brew pubs or grocery store beer permits shall be unlawful on
43 Thanksgiving Day, New Year's Day or Christmas; and such sale or
44 dispensing of alcoholic liquor in places operating under package store
45 permits, drug store permits, manufacturer permits, manufacturer
46 permits for beer, manufacturer permits for beer and brew pubs and

47 grocery store beer permits shall be unlawful on Sunday before ten
48 o'clock a.m. and after five o'clock p.m. and on any other day before
49 eight o'clock a.m. and after nine o'clock p.m. It shall be unlawful for
50 the holder of a manufacturer permit for a brew pub to sell beer for
51 consumption off the premises on the days or hours prohibited by this
52 subsection. Any town may, by a vote of a town meeting or by
53 ordinance, reduce the number of hours during which such sale shall be
54 permissible."
