**"AN ACT CONCERNING MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE PROVIDERS AND DISTRACTED DRIVING."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 14-314 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2013*):

5 (a) Any person, firm or corporation failing to comply with any order  
6 made pursuant to any provision of this chapter shall be fined not more  
7 than five thousand dollars or imprisoned not more than thirty days or  
8 both, and shall be subject to the provisions of section 14-111. [Any]

9 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, any person,  
10 firm or corporation [failing] that fails to comply with any traffic control  
11 signal, sign, marking or other device placed and maintained upon the  
12 highway, or with any regulation adopted pursuant to any provision of  
13 this chapter, by the Office of the State Traffic Administration or the  
14 traffic authority of any city, town or borough shall be deemed to have

15 committed an infraction, if no other penalty is provided by law.

16 (c) Any person who violates the provisions of subsection (b) of this  
17 section while operating a truck upon a highway with a traffic control  
18 signal, sign, marking or other device placed and maintained upon the  
19 highway with respect to the prohibition of through truck traffic on  
20 such highway shall be deemed to have committed an infraction, if no  
21 other penalty is provided by law, unless such person (1) has obtained a  
22 permit pursuant to section 14-270 which permits the operation of such  
23 truck on such highway, or (2) presents evidence of an origin or  
24 destination of such truck within a municipality through which such  
25 highway passes.

26 (d) Traveling at a greater rate of speed than is reasonable as  
27 provided in section 14-218a shall not be deemed to be a failure to  
28 comply with the provisions of this section but shall be deemed to be  
29 the commission of an infraction within the provisions of said section  
30 14-218a."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
