**"AN ACT CONCERNING LICENSED ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELORS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2013*) Notwithstanding the  
4 provisions of title 20 of the general statutes, no person shall  
5 independently engage in the practice of orthopedic surgery until such  
6 person has (1) graduated from a five-year residency program in  
7 orthopedic medicine and surgery, and (2) has performed orthopedic  
8 surgery on a full-time basis for a period of two years under the direct  
9 supervision of a physician or surgeon licensed under chapter 370 of the  
10 general statutes who is certified by the American Board of Orthopedic  
11 Surgery and is practicing in the same specialty area of orthopedic  
12 surgery in which such person intends to practice."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
