THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 2015."**

6 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
7 internal references accordingly:

8 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2013*) Notwithstanding the Revised
9 SEBAC Agreement, approved by the General Assembly on August 22,
10 2011: (1) Wage increases for all state employees, whether or not subject
11 to collective bargaining agreements, shall be eliminated for the fiscal
12 years ending June 30, 2014, and June 30, 2015, (2) longevity payments

13 for all state employees subject to collective bargaining agreements shall
 14 be suspended for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2014, and June 30,
 15 2015, (3) increases to longevity payments for all managerial state
 16 employees shall be eliminated, (4) contributions made by state
 17 employees to the State Employees Retirement System shall be
 18 increased by two per cent.

19 Sec. 502. (*Effective July 1, 2013*) The amounts specified in lines T832,
 20 T833 and T834 of this act shall be adjusted to reflect a total Statewide
 21 Hiring Reduction lapse increase of \$30,000,000 for each of the fiscal
 22 years ending June 30, 2014, and June 30, 2015.

23 Sec. 503. (*Effective July 1, 2013*) Each hospital receiving state aid is
 24 authorized to use all appropriate means to maximize federal revenue."
