**"AN ACT CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF CONNECTICUT'S
COMPREHENSIVE ENERGY STRATEGY."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
4 section 9-701 of the general statutes, the sum of \$6,200,000 shall be
5 transferred from the Citizens' Election Fund and credited to the
6 resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014.

7 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
8 section 9-701 of the general statutes, the sum of \$24,200,000 shall be
9 transferred from the Citizens' Election Fund and credited to the
10 resources of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015.

11 Sec. 503. (*Effective July 1, 2015*) All moneys in the Citizens' Election
12 Fund, established in section 9-701 of the general statutes, shall be

13 transferred from said fund and credited to the resources of the General
 14 Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

15 Sec. 504. Sections 106 and 107 of house bill 6704 of the current
 16 session are repealed. (*Effective from passage*)

17 Sec. 505. Sections 9-700 to 9-712, inclusive, 9-715 to 9-719, inclusive,
 18 9-750 and 9-751 of the general statutes are repealed. (*Effective July 1,*
 19 *2015*)"
