PROPOSED BILL No. 5733

An act Concerning Access to a Childs Death Certificate

Good Morning Senator Gerratana, Representative Johnson and Members of the Committee.

My name is Monica Duhancik. I have been an Assistant Town Clerk for the Town of Newtown for the past 7 years and also a lifetime resident.

I am testifying today in support of House Bill No. 5733, An act concerning Access to a Childs Death Certificate.

In the wake of the devastating events that took place on December 14, 2012, at the Sandy Hook Elementary School it has painfully been brought to my attention, that death records recorded in the office of the Town Clerk are of public access. Should a request be made for a copy of such record, the law says we are to issue a certified copy and charge the enforced fee of \$20.00 each. Requests, indeed, have been made for copies of the death records of our 20 children and six adults we lost that day. These requests came from "The Press" and "The Media".

I would ask that you consider the restriction of public access to all death records, especially minors, to the "public". Access to these records should only be for immediate family (i.e. Parents, Grandparents, Aunts, Uncles & Siblings). This is out of respect to the privacy of family members related to the deceased. More importantly, to keep this information out of the hands of any possible identity theft.

Please consider this as a possible solution, similar to our “wallet size” Birth Certificates. We would be able to fill a Public Request on a Death record in a wallet size format which would include only:
Name of Deceased, Date of Death, Place of Death & Sex.

Excluding any and all other information by omitting informants name, address, mothers maiden name, place of burial, social security numbers etc. and even cause of death.

This wallet size Death Certificate would cost \$15.00 each (just as we currently charge for the wallet size Birth Certificate).

In closing, I thank you for your time and the opportunity to testify in favor of re-evaluating Public accessibility regarding Death Records of minors.
