I am here to speak in favor of bill 6590.

I was never under the impression that a Tattoo Technician was not licensed; similar to a nurse who is licensed. They both put needles into your body that penetrate your skin. Tattoo Technicians claim they don't need licensing because they have doctors overseeing them; so do nurses and they have to be licensed. I had one constituent that told me her technician came forward with the tattoo materials ready to start the procedure. She asked him why everything was uncovered; he answered that he uncovered everything at the counter. She walked out. This is one example of what can happen when an individual tattoo technician has not proven their qualifications in order to obtain a license. Please give moving this bill forward serious consideration.
