As a 73-year-old giving careful consideration to the end of life, I urge you to support House Bill 6645 reforming the rules for medical assistance in ending life for those who are terminally ill and competent to make their own decisions. I consider my ability to make such a decision a civil right, which the law should not prevent me from exercising. A similar aid-in-dying law has worked very well in Oregon, with no history of abuse. Connecticut should lead the way in extending it to our own citizens.
