Dear Connecticut Public Health Committee Member,

After 22 years of smoking, I now use a nicotine vaporizer instead of smoking. I have heard that SB990 would force me to stand in a smoking area to use my nicotine vaporizer in Connecticut. I am sure that as one of your constituents, you do not want me to be exposed to second hand tobacco smoke now that I have quit smoking. I find the odor very offensive. I wanted to make sure that you understand that there is no tobacco and no combustion in a nicotine vaporizer/ electronic cigarette and therefore there is no smoke. It only makes vapor.

As a non smoker, I feel that it violates my right to a smoke free environment if I am forced to stand in a smoking area. I am sure this would be an unintended consequence of the proposed bill. Tobacco cigarettes deliver over 4000 dangerous chemicals, but electronic cigarettes deliver nicotine without those dangerous chemicals or offensive odor. I often use my electronic cigarette indoors and due to the lack of odor and the fact that my e-cigarette looks nothing like a cigarette it is rarely even noticed.

I would please ask you to get more information about the device and to learn the truth for yourself before voting on this bill. I am a member of the National Vapers Club and they commissioned a study completed at Clarkson University that showed that e-cigarette vapor does not harm the people around me.
