In accordance with section 4-168(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Insurance Commissioner, pursuant to the authority of section 38a-88 of the Connecticut General Statutes and Connecticut Public Act No. 12-139, proposes to amend regulations concerning credit for reinsurance.

Statement of purpose: To update the provisions of regulations concerning credit for reinsurance to implement the provisions of Public Act No. 12-139.

In accordance with section 4-168(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Insurance Commissioner, pursuant to the authority of section 38a-138 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended by Public Act 12-103 proposes to adopt amended regulations concerning the Holding Company Act.

Statement of purpose: To amend the Holding Company Act Regulations to conform to the Holding Company Act as amended by Public Act 12-103 and sections 126 and 127 of Public Act 12-2 of the June 12 Special Session.

Oral comments will be limited to five minutes and must address the proposed regulations.

Statement of purpose: To amend the regulation to be consistent with state statutory changes which have changed the terminology from "viatical" to "life settlement" as well as other related terminology changes. Consistent with Connecticut's laws, protection from discrimination based on an individual's gender identity or expression is being added.
