STATE IMPACT OF REGULATION:

The Department of Social Services seeks to amend the regulations of the Department by adding sections 17b-262-817 to 17b-262-828. These sections pertain to the payment of Behavioral Health Clinic Services.

The purpose of the proposed regulation is to establish, in regulation form, the requirements for payment of behavioral health clinic services provided to individuals covered by the Medicaid program. The problems, issues or circumstances that the regulation proposes to address are to: (1) add new definitions as necessary; (2)

incorporate current practice; and (3) clarify the prior authorization process, documentation requirements and billing procedures.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

There is no anticipated state fiscal impact associated with the addition of these sections to the existing regulations as these changes are technical in nature.
