#### Notice of Intent to Amend Regulations Rates of Pilotage for Connecticut Marine Pilots

The Commissioner of Transportation, pursuant to Sections 4-168; 15-14, and 15-15a of the Connecticut General Statutes, hereby gives notice of his intent to amend regulations regarding rates of pilotage for Connecticut marine pilots.

The purpose of the proposed amendments is implement a three percent (3%) increase per year for four years to the current marine pilotage rates, codify established charges and practices for pilot boat fees and the associated temporary pilot boat fuel surcharge, and establish a pilot training and safety equipment account.

#### Notice of Intent to Seek Amendment of Medicaid Waiver for Comprehensive Supports Waiver

In accordance with the provisions of section 17b-8(c) of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Commissioner of Social Services intends to submit an amendment on behalf of the Department of Developmental Services Comprehensive Support waiver to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to be effective retroactive to October 1, 2012.

The amendment proposes to: increase the number of participants served (slots) in Year 5 of the waiver from 4800 participants to 4950 participants.
