Notice of Intent to Adopt Regulations

In accordance with the provisions of Section 4-168 of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Labor Commissioner, pursuant to §§ 4-8 and 4-167 of the Connecticut General Statutes, and under the authority of CGS §§ 7-471, 10-153e, 5-273(b), 31-106(b), proposes to amend Department of Labor regulations pertaining to the State Labor Relations Board.

Statement of Purpose: The proposed amendments are intended to (a) bring the regulatory language into conformity with statutory language; (b) bring the regulatory language into conformity with the requirements of the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, Sections 4-166 et seq. of the General Statutes; (c) bring the regulatory language into conformity with current administrative procedure of the board; (d) make technical corrections to the Regulations; and (e) create internal consistency among the regulations.
