Bamboo releases 35% more oxygen than native trees. An acre of bamboo can sequester 25 tons of carbon dioxide per year, compared to only 6 tons from a young forest. Bamboo guzzles greenhouse gases!

LANDSCAPING ? CONSIDER BAMBOO

1. Lush, green, evoking tropical climes = sensual, meditative, refuge
2. Vertical habit screens and encloses = providing privacy
3. Many evergreen species = year-round interest, windbreaks
4. Once established, drought and pollutant tolerant = tough and durable
5. Attractive to many types of birds for nesting = wildlife habitat
6. Grove-creating rhizome root system = erosion control on slopes
7. Grove-creating woodland = intriguing playgrounds for children
8. Recycles carbon dioxide = cleans the air
9. Edible, yummy shoots = food source
10. Renewal resource = harvest for thousands of uses
