To Rep. Sandy Nafis and Members of the Environment Committee;

I have two grandsons who play hockey at our local arena. The eldest (age twelve) plays two games and has two practices each week. This means he spends approximately six hours a week at the arena. My youngest grandson (age eight) is learning to play hockey and spends at least two hours a week at the arena. I have noticed high levels of propane emissions/exhaust after the Zamboni cleans the ice surface before a game or practice. This level of exhaust cannot be healthy for our children/grandchildren, some as young as four to or five years of age. I believe there should be some standard or regulation setting air quality in all the arenas throughout the state.
