The Committee on Transportation reported through REP. GUERRERA of the 29th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2014*) The Department of Motor Vehicles
2 shall study recent improvements to motor vehicle registration in New
3 England states and the state of New York. Not later than February 1,
4 2015, the department shall report, in accordance with the provisions of
5 section 11-4a of the general statutes, the findings of such study and the
6 feasibility and the costs and benefits of undertaking similar
7 improvements in this state to the joint standing committee of the
8 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
9 transportation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
