Senate Bill No. 347

The Committee on Appropriations reported through SEN. BYE of the 5th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES OF APPROPRIATED FUNDS OTHER THAN THE GENERAL FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Office of Fiscal Analysis shall
2 conduct a review of appropriations authorized from appropriated
3 funds other than the General Fund in the state budget for the biennium
4 ending June 30, 2015, and shall identify general areas of spending for
5 which appropriations increased by ten per cent or more over
6 appropriations authorized from such funds in the state budget for the
7 immediately preceding biennium. On or before February 1, 2015, said
8 office shall submit, in accordance with section 11-4a of the general
9 statutes, the results of its review to the joint standing committee of the
10 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
11 appropriations.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
