Our members represent over 92% of Connecticut's population. We appreciate the opportunity to testify on bills of interest to towns and cities.

SB 348 "An Act Concerning Post-Election Audits"

CCM supports SB 348.

This bill would modify the post-election audit requirement by (1) no longer requiring a manual audit, and (2) reducing the threshold of precincts to be audited from 10% to 5%.

Post-election audits are costly and time consuming for local governments. Providing some relief from having to undergo some of the costly and time consuming endeavors during the audit process would benefit local election officials and their budgets.

CCM asks the Committee to favorably report SB 348.
