Re: - Nicholas Kerwick Savino

Dear Juliana McMillian:

I am the Guardian of Nicholas Benedict Savino, jointly appointed by Kenneth Savino and Colleen Kerwick at his birth. I am an attorney at law, an arbitrator and the managing partner of the law offices of David A Bredin. I am a licensed attorney in three European member states and have rights of audience in commonwealth countries.

I have many concerns regarding Kenneth Savino, and I am gravely concerned at how this may affect Nicholas and the toll it is taking on his mother. I am sorry to say that Kenneth is a very manipulative person and I believe he is attempting to game the system, to use his son as a pawn.

Colleen, has waived many of her rights and have stepped down from positions so that the divorce, which includes the custody be resolved in an amicable manner; but Kenneth had not made this divorce easy on her or his child.

I would like to advise you when my wife and I vacationed with the Savinos in November 2010 at a private island of Ambergris Cay in the Turks & Caicos, I came to observe the parents interaction with Nicholas in a more detailed way than previously. Around that time, the island was in part evacuated because of Hurricane Thomas. Kenneth ignored the evacuation warning to stay to protect his real estate investment, and Nicholas should not have been endangered in this Hurricane for the sake of Kens investment.

In February 2011, I received a frantic call from Colleen from a hotel room in Ireland. She said Ken hit her and she was scared. She said that she had been upset with Ken as he had kept Nicholas up all day after an overnight flight to get him on his schedule. The following day, I received a message that Nicholas was in hospital with status epilepticus. Nicholas health should not have been endangered for the sake of Kens schedule.

Ken has used the very many resources at his disposal to keep Colleen in Connecticut away from her friends, family and job in NY and refused to give her financial support for Nicholas. He endorsed her as the primary parent prior to the separation by his absenteeism, so a question needs to be answered why he would deprive her of support for Nicholas at this juncture.

This situation needs to be remedied with respect and the best interests of Nicholas needs to take center stage, and I appeal to you not to allow a person with great wealth, paint the picture he so
