

Peggy Twitchell testimony in support of SB 46

Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in support of SB-46, An Act Concerning Pesticides on School Grounds. Connecticut's robust pesticide protections for kids up to grade 8 should be extended to include high school students, especially since young children often use high school fields for soccer games, field hockey practice, etc.
