AN ACT INCREASING THE PERSONAL NEEDS ALLOWANCE FOR CERTAIN LONG-TERM CARE RESIDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17b-106 of the 2014 supplement to the general statutes
- 2 and section 17b-272 of the general statutes be amended to increase the
- 3 personal needs allowance from sixty to one hundred dollars for long-
- 4 term care facility residents who receive state medical assistance.

Statement of Purpose:

To raise the personal needs allowance to a sufficient level to ensure residents can pay for basic personal needs, such as clothing and hair cuts.
