**AN ACT INCREASING ECS AID TO TOWNS TO COMPENSATE FOR  
THE MAGNET SCHOOL TUITION REQUIREMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-262h of the general statutes be repealed and that
- 2 chapter 172 of the general statutes be amended to increase state aid
- 3 under the education cost sharing formula to compensate towns for
- 4 losses incurred as a result of being responsible for paying the tuition of
- 5 students attending interdistrict magnet schools.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To compensate towns for the increased local costs in meeting the state requirement that towns pay the tuition for students attending interdistrict magnet schools.
