**AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR THE
SHELTERING OF LOST ANIMALS FOLLOWING SEVERE WEATHER
EMERGENCIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that municipal
- 2 expenses related to the sheltering of lost animals following a severe
- 3 weather emergency be deemed a reimbursable cost for the purpose of
- 4 distributing federal funds received in connection with such a severe
- 5 weather emergency.

Statement of Purpose:

To reimburse towns for the cost of sheltering lost animals following severe weather emergencies.
