***AN ACT RESTORING THE SALES TAX EXEMPTION FOR CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-412 of the 2014 supplement to the general statutes be
- 2 amended to restore the clothing and footwear tax exemption as of
- 3 April 1, 2014. One hundred sixty-seven million six hundred thousand
- 4 dollars of the state's excess revenue shall be dedicated to pay for
- 5 restoring the exemption.
