***AN ACT CONCERNING SAFETY AND CERTIFICATION STANDARDS
FOR THE SPRAY FOAM INSULATION INDUSTRY.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of
2 Consumer Protection, after consultation with the Commissioners of
3 Public Health and Energy and Environmental Protection, shall adopt
4 regulations, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 54 of the
5 general statutes, to establish safety and certification standards for the
6 spray foam insulation industry. Such regulations shall require all spray
7 foam installers operating in this state to obtain training, credentialing
8 or certification under programs established by the American
9 Chemistry Council's Center for the Polyurethane Industry and the
10 Spray Polyurethane Foam Alliance, in consultation with the United
11 States Environmental Protection Agency, the National Institute for
12 Occupational Safety and Health, and the Occupational Safety and
13 Health Administration.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
