**AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR GREATER
WATERBURY YMCA FOR AN AFTER-SCHOOL AND EVENING
COLLEGE PREPARATION INITIATIVE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
4 two hundred fifty thousand dollars, the proceeds of which shall be
5 used by the Department of Education for the purpose of providing a
6 grant-in-aid to the Greater Waterbury YMCA for a two-year after-
7 school and evening college preparation initiative for minority high
8 school students that will prepare such students for examinations taken
9 for college admission and expedite their transition into higher
10 education courses.

initiative for minority students.
