**AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE "SAVE THE STATE" LICENSE PLATE  
TO PAY DOWN LONG-TERM DEBT OF THE STATE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to (1) authorize the issuance of
- 2 "Save the State" license plates, which may be purchased for a fee, in
- 3 addition to the registration fee, in the amount of fifty-five dollars; (2)
- 4 establish a nonlapsing account into which such fee shall be deposited;
- 5 (3) permit state residents to pay such fee by directing a portion of any
- 6 tax rebate offered by the state in an amount of fifty-five dollars or
- 7 greater for single filers into such account; and (4) require that funds for
- 8 the sale of such license plates be used annually to pay down long-term
- 9 debt of the state.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To create a "Save the State" special license plate for the purpose of raising funds to pay down long-term state debt.
