AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXEMPTION FROM SALES AND USE TAX OF CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-412 of the general statutes be amended to restore the
- 2 clothing and footwear exemption fourteen months earlier than
- 3 scheduled, beginning April 1, 2014. One hundred sixty-seven million
- 4 six hundred thousand dollars from the state's excess revenue shall be
- 5 dedicated to pay for restoring the exemption.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide tax relief for those items that are essential to our residents' everyday lives.
