**AN ACT RESTORING THE EXEMPTION FROM SALES AND USE TAXES FOR NONPRESCRIPTION DRUGS AND MEDICINES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to restore the exemption on
- 2 nonprescription drugs and medicines beginning April 1, 2014. The
- 3 revenue loss shall be offset by the use of ten million eight hundred
- 4 thousand dollars of the state's excess revenue, and by keeping the
- 5 earned income tax credit at the current twenty-five per cent level.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To provide tax relief for those items that are essential to our residents' everyday lives.
