**AN ACT CONCERNING THE COLLECTION AND PROCESSING OF
DNA SAMPLES FROM PERSONS ARRESTED FOR A SERIOUS
FELONY OFFENSE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that the
- 2 Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection and police
- 3 departments collect and process DNA (deoxyribonucleic acid) samples
- 4 to the full extent allowed under public act 11-207, and that relevant
- 5 agencies receive adequate funding for such purpose.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for DNA samples be collected and processed to the full
extent allowed by law.
