***AN ACT CONCERNING UNEMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS AND
DISCRIMINATORY HIRING PRACTICES.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (6) of subsection (a) of section 46a-60 of the
2 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
3 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2014*):

4 (6) For any person, employer, employment agency or labor
5 organization, except in the case of a bona fide occupational
6 qualification or need, to advertise employment opportunities in such a
7 manner as to restrict such employment so as to discriminate against
8 [individuals because of their] any individual because (A) of such
9 individual's race, color, religious creed, age, sex, gender identity or
10 expression, marital status, national origin, ancestry, present or past
11 history of mental disability, intellectual disability, learning disability or
12 physical disability, including, but not limited to, blindness, or (B) such
13 individual is unemployed;
