AN ACT CONCERNING MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 14-18 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2014*):

4 (a) (1) Each motor vehicle for which one number plate has been
5 issued shall, while in use or operation upon any public highway,
6 display in a conspicuous place at the rear of such vehicle the number
7 plate. [The commissioner may issue a sticker denoting the expiration
8 date of the registration. Such sticker shall be displayed in such place on
9 the vehicle as the commissioner may direct.] Each such motor vehicle
10 shall also display the sticker issued in accordance with section 14-12, as
11 amended by this act, denoting the expiration date of the registration.
12 Such sticker may contain the corresponding letters and numbers of the
13 registration and number plate, [issued] as assigned by the
14 commissioner.

15 (2) Each motor vehicle for which two number plates have been

16 issued shall, while in use or operation upon any public highway,
17 display in a conspicuous place at the front and the rear of such vehicle
18 the number plates. [The commissioner may issue a sticker denoting the
19 expiration date of the registration. Such sticker shall be displayed in
20 such place on the vehicle as the commissioner may direct. Such sticker]
21 Each such motor vehicle shall also display the sticker issued in
22 accordance with section 14-12, as amended by this act, denoting the
23 expiration date of the registration, which may contain the
24 corresponding letters and numbers of the registration and number
25 plate, [issued] as assigned by the commissioner.

26 Sec. 2. Section 14-12 of the general statutes is amended by adding
27 subsection (l) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2014*):

28 (NEW) (l) Each registration certificate or registration renewal
29 certificate issued for a motor vehicle shall be accompanied by a sticker
30 denoting the expiration date of such registration. Such sticker shall be
31 displayed inside the rear windshield or elsewhere on the vehicle, as
32 the commissioner may direct, at all times during the period for which
33 such registration is effective.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Sec. 2	<i>October 1, 2014</i>	14-12

Statement of Purpose:

To require motor vehicles to display verification of registration.
