AN ACT CONCERNING THE CLAIM AGAINST THE STATE OF THE TOWN OF CHESHIRE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the failure to
2 file a proper notice of a claim against the state with the clerk of the
3 Office of the Claims Commissioner, as required by section 4-147 of the
4 general statutes, within the time limitations specified by subsection (a)
5 of section 4-148 of the general statutes, the town of Cheshire is
6 authorized pursuant to the provisions of subsection (b) of section 4-148
7 of the general statutes to present its claim against the state to the
8 Claims Commissioner. The General Assembly deems such
9 authorization to be just and equitable and finds that such authorization
10 is supported by compelling equitable circumstances and would serve a
11 public purpose.

12 (b) The state shall be barred from setting up the failure to comply
13 with the provisions of sections 4-147 and 4-148 of the general statutes,
14 from denying that notice of the claim was properly and timely given
15 pursuant to sections 4-147 and 4-148 of the general statutes and from
16 setting up the fact that the claim had once been considered by the

17 Claims Commissioner, by the General Assembly or in a judicial
18 proceeding as defenses to such claim.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
