AN ACT CONCERNING SCHOOL READINESS FUNDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (2) of subsection (b) of section 10-16q of the
2 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
3 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2014*):

4 (2) For the fiscal year ending June 30, [2009] 2015, and each fiscal
5 year thereafter, the per child cost of the Department of Education
6 school readiness program offered by a school readiness provider shall
7 not exceed [eight thousand three hundred forty-six dollars] (A) nine
8 thousand dollars for a full-day program, and (B) four thousand five
9 hundred dollars for a part-day program.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
