***AN ACT PERMITTING THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON LEGISLATIVE
MANAGEMENT TO PURCHASE CERTAIN GOODS AND SERVICES
USING EXISTING CONTRACTS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 2-71v of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 (a) The Joint Committee on Legislative Management may join with
4 federal agencies, other state governments, political subdivisions of this
5 state or nonprofit organizations in cooperative purchasing plans when
6 the best interests of the state would be served thereby.

7 (b) The Joint Committee on Legislative Management may purchase
8 equipment, supplies, materials, information systems,
9 telecommunication systems and services from a person who has a
10 contract to sell such goods or services to other state governments,
11 political subdivisions of the state, nonprofit organizations or public
12 purchasing consortia, in accordance with the terms and conditions of
13 such contract, when the best interest of the state would be served. Any

14 purchase made pursuant to this subsection shall not constitute a
15 waiver of any rights or protections provided under any provision of
16 the general statutes to the General Assembly.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To allow the Joint Committee on Legislative Management to join with governmental entities and other entities who have an existing contract for the purchase of certain goods and services.
