AN ACT ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL SECURITY PERSONNEL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 7-294x of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2014*):

3 The Police Officer Standards and Training Council established
4 under section 7-294b, in consultation with the Department of
5 Education, shall establish standards for and provide training to
6 security personnel employed in the public schools by a local or
7 regional board of education. Such standards shall include minimum
8 qualifications for any security personnel who are not current or retired
9 police officers. Such training shall include drug detection and gang
10 identification.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
