AN ACT ESTABLISHING FIRST RESPONDER DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the 2014 supplement to
- 2 the general statutes is amended by adding subdivision (66) as follows
- 3 (*Effective from passage*):
- 4 (NEW) (66) The Governor shall proclaim September twenty-seventh
- 5 of each year to be First Responder Day in recognition of the service,
- 6 sacrifice and contribution of such personnel to the public health and
- 7 safety. Suitable exercises shall be held in the State Capitol and
- 8 elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance of the day.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To establish September twenty-seventh of each year as First Responder Day.
