AN ACT CONCERNING THE MAXIMUM DECIBEL LEVEL AT MOVIE THEATRES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2014*) (a) No person holding a
2 license under the provisions of section 29-117 of the general statutes
3 shall exhibit or show any moving picture film or preview film that
4 exceeds eighty-five decibels. The Commissioner of Administrative
5 Services shall establish the procedure for checking maximum decibel
6 levels to determine compliance with this section.

7 (b) Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be
8 subject to the provisions of section 29-111 of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
