AN ACT CONCERNING CERTIFICATES OF PERMISSION FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF CERTAIN PILINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the
- 2 provisions of sections 22a-363a and 22a-363b of the general statutes, a
- 3 certificate of permission shall not be required for the replacement of a
- 4 piling upon the same footing as the original piling.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

To allow for the replacement of a piling on the same footing as the original piling without the need to obtain a certificate of permission.
