AN ACT CONCERNING CAPIAS MITTIMUS ORDERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (d) of section 52-56 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
3 *October 1, 2014*):

4 (d) The execution or service of any capias issued pursuant to section
5 52-143 or 54-2a or any warrant or capias mittimus issued by a court or
6 family support magistrate in a family support matter may be made in
7 any precinct in the state by any state marshal of any precinct, [or] any
8 special [policeman] police officer appointed under section 29-1g, or
9 any judicial marshal authorized under section 46b-225, having such
10 capias, warrant or capias mittimus, or a copy thereof made by any
11 photographic, micrographic, electronic imaging or other process,
12 which clearly and accurately copies such original document, in his or
13 her hands for service.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
