**AN ACT CONCERNING THE SAFETY OF CERTAIN PROCESSED FOODS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of  
2 Consumer Protection may adopt regulations, in accordance with  
3 chapter 54 of the general statutes, to require processors of meat,  
4 poultry or juice to adopt and implement a hazard analysis critical  
5 control point plan. As used in this section, "hazard analysis critical  
6 control point plan" means a systematic approach designed to prevent,  
7 eliminate or reduce to acceptable levels the presence of microbial,  
8 chemical and physical hazards associated with the production of meat,  
9 poultry and juice.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
